

# EDU503 Implementation of Content (3 credit hours) Course Syllabus

## **Course Description**

The course covers considerations related to the practical aspects of the planning, delivery, and evaluation of content. In this course, students will prepare an implementation plan based on a specific use case, decide on an appropriate delivery mode, and prepare supportive materials.

#### **Course Learning Outcomes**

By the end of this course, you will be able to:

- 1. Recommend appropriate delivery strategies based on institutional and learner needs.
- 2. Implement formative evaluation of course content and delivery.
- 3. Create support materials and structures for users.

### Required Textbook(s) and Resources

Effective time management is possibly the single most critical element to your academic success.
